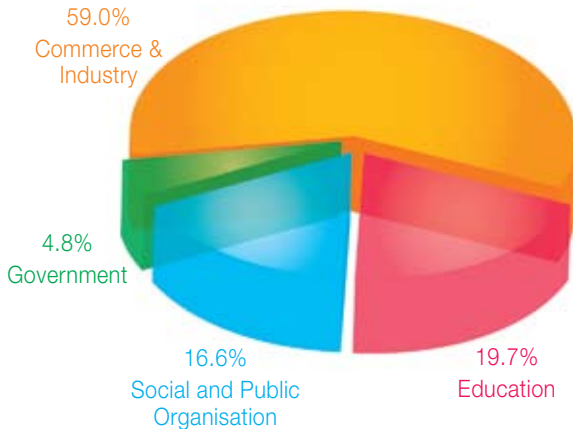


PROSPECTS OF GRADUATES



CUHK graduates have always enjoyed excellent career prospects. Our critical, globally minded and culturally sophisticated graduates are highly welcomed by prospective employers. In recent years, about 90% of respondents to our annual employment surveys were given their first job offers by the end of September in the year they graduated. The employment situation of graduates in 2009 is summarised below.

THE TOP FIVE CAREER FIELDS ENGAGED BY 2009 FIRST-DEGREE GRADUATES

Career Fields	Percentage of Respondents in Employment ⁽¹⁾
Administration/Management	12.0%
Teaching	11.3%
Information Technology	10.7%
Medical and Health Services	10.6%
Accounting/Auditing	10.4%
Total	55.0%
