



Reference Scores for Major International Qualifications

Prospective students may refer to reference scores for major international qualifications below in planning their application for admission in 2020 entry and beyond. Reference scores are compiled with reference to admission statistics in 2017, 2018 and 2019 entries. The **highest scores** achieved by students admitted to CUHK on the strength of IB Diploma, GCE AL / IAL and Redesigned SAT were **45** (out of 45), **5A*** and **1560** (out of 1600) respectively. The lowest reference score ranges of undergraduate programmes based on admission statistics in the same period are summarized below.

Please note that admission is not based on public examination results alone, and the overall scores of students admitted to each programme vary from year to year, the information provided is for reference only and should not be used to predict the chance of admission to any programme in subsequent years.
