Course Description

(Unless otherwise specified, all are 3-unit term courses of two hours of lecture and one hour of tutorial per week.)

CHP 1520

Chinese for Executives

This course is to train students, through examples and practice, in skills of written Chinese required for an executive in commercial or government institution. (Not for students who have taken CHP 1510.)

ELP 1107

English Improvement Strategies

3 U; 3 Classwork

This course integrates normal classroom instruction with the self-access language learning approach. It focuses on introducing strategies for improving listening and speaking in English and utilizing resources for practice in an independent way. The course aims at providing ways of solving language problems and at encouraging students to be responsible for their own language learning and improvement. Evaluation and assessment are based on normal classroom participation and completion of assigned practice activities done independently.

ELP 1109

English Improvement Strategies for Vocabulary Expansion

This course is designed for students who want to expand their vocabulary in English. Specifically, it will focus on developing strategies for learning, remembering and using vocabulary appropriately. This course also encourages students to assume responsibility for managing their own vocabulary learning. Coursework will include group discussions, presentations, practice activities, a project and keeping a learning journal.

GRP 1110

German Language: Beginners I

3 U; 3 Classwork

This course does not require any prior knowledge of German. As the first in a sequence of six courses, it lays the foundations for all further German language studies. It provides basic training in spoken German, emphasizing oral skills and listening comprehension. A general introduction to German culture and customs goes together with the language instruction.

Study Scheme
