A **3-credit** CUHK language and culture Immersion programme for <u>intermediate</u> and advanced Chinese language learners.

**PRINCH** is a task-based programme which actualizes the idea of "learn to use and use to learn". It is carefully designed to provide intermediate and advanced Chinese language learners with the opportunity to use language appropriately in real life for effective communication purposes. First launch in 2006, PRINCH allows students to practice what they have learned in class through a variety of activities in the target culture, an approach that has been recognized by professionals and highly recommended as a most effective means to cultivate pragmatic competence of language learners. Class format consists of three parts, (1) Classroom activities with CLC head teacher(s). (2) Theme-based trip in small groups led by local teachers and (3) Post-trip tasks with teachers, such as Q&A, discussion and presentation. Themes include history, religion, commerce, customs and culture, education and modern living etc.



# Host School in Beijing (北京)

**Belling** is the capital of the People's Republic of China. It is the second largest Chinese city by urban population after Shanghai and is the nation's political, cultural, and educational centre. The city's history dates back three millennia. Beijing has been the political centre of the country for much of the past seven centuries. The city is renowned for its opulent palaces, temples, gardens, tombs, walls and gates, and its art treasures and universities have made it a centre of culture and art in China. Few cities in the world have been the political and cultural centre of an area as immense for so long.



## College of International Education, Minzu University of China (MUC-CIE)

Minzu University of China (MUC) is one of China's most important comprehensive universities, and it is one of the 38 key universities receiving direct development support from the Chinese government. Minzu University of China has a comprehensive set of university disciplines, and its ethnic characteristics are highly distinctive. Humanities is its main focus and ethnic studies is its defining specialty, with courses covering liberal arts, science, engineering, medical science, management, education, finance and economics, politics and law, physical education, art and so on. MUC is a microcosm of the big family of Chinese ethnic groups, and it is the only university in China where all of China's 56 ethnic groups are represented in its faculty and student body. At present, MUC has 23 colleges and 5 departments, 55 bachelor's degree programs, 64 master's degree programs, and 25 doctor's degree programs. Its ethnology, Chinese ethnic minority language and literature, Chinese ethnic minority art and etc. rank the first in China and are well-known in the world.

## Student admission and preparation

- Applicants should be <u>non-native speakers of Putonghua</u> who have studied at least 400 hours of Chinese (Putonghua). For CLC Regular Programme students and CUHK IUG/IPG and exchange students, a good score attained at level 2 or above is an advantage. Applicants who have never studied with CLC, please complete a placement test for full-time students by following the instruction at www.cuhk.edu.hk/clc/placement and send in the placement information together with the application form.
- Students should try to <u>understand</u> the unique learning mode in this course in comparison to the usual language class. There is no formal text book and teaching in form of lecture in the PRINCH programme. Students are expected to take an active approach in learning, such as data search, preparing questions for tasks, speak up, sound and video recording etc.
- Students should carry a battery fully charged <u>recording device</u> every lesson to enhance their learning in PRINCH, such as smart phone with sound and video recording function, MP3 recorder etc.

#Other fees include: small group counseling cost, trans-city transportation (round trip air ticket between Hong Kong and Beijing); local transportation in Beijing; accommodation in Beijing (13 nights in 3-star rating guest house, double-occupancy); admission ticket related to the language activities, programme materials, welcome and farewell dinner, and travel insurance. Meals will be at students' own expense according to one's living style.

Fees do not include: meals (unless otherwise specified), China visa charge, single room surcharge, activities outside course requirement and course hours, accommodation and traveling related to any extended stay, (if applicable) personal gift to home visit family. For budgeting purposes, students should allow a daily pocket money of RMB100-300 for meals and other expenses according to one's individual living style. Telephone card and internet access can be arranged at students' expense after arrival.

Landing option: it is only available by request and not preferable. Students who take this option have to arrange transportation between Hong Kong and the Beijing hotel on their own. The "other fee" will be reduced by HK\$2000. Students should punctually meet the group at designated time in the hotel. No pick up support will be provided.

# Special offer to CLC Advanced Diploma (A. Dip) Putonghua students and graduates

A 40% reimbursement on "Other fees" is provided to CLC A. Dip. Putonghua students and graduates. Students please pay the full fee first. The "Other fees" will be refunded together with the school deposit to eligible students upon leaving the school after completion of the A. Dip programme (regardless of the result in the graduation exam). Students should indicate their request of this refund to the general office together with the school deposit refund. No reminder will be given to students from the Centre's side. Reimbursement claim for PRINCH after the school deposit refund is not allowed. The reimbursement offer is for one time only for each A. Dip student/ graduate throughout their study.

**PRINCH** is a compulsory capstone course for A. Dip Putonghua students in the new curriculum. A. Dip candidates are expected to take 8 advanced courses and PRINCH, or otherwise to take 11 advanced courses to fulfill the graduation requirement.

- 2. Fill in (1) the application form. (2) Terms and Conditions for CLC/CUHK Sponsored Programmes. (3) Health Declaration Form. (4) Letter to PRINCH participants on the purpose of collection of multi-media materials in the programme.
- 3. A hard copy or scanned copy of your passport, which shows: (1) The page which contains your photo and personal information. (2) The page with your valid Hong Kong visa. In the case of permanent HK resident, a copy of your HKID card. (3) The page with your valid China visa. In the case of permanent HK residents, Home Return Permit (Hui Xiang Zheng), if applicable.
- 4. Fees must be fully settled to confirm a seat. First-come-first-serve.

Payment: All fees must be settled to confirm a seat.

#### Cancellation and refunds

- Withdrawal before application deadline: full refund except application fee (if applicable).
- Withdrawal after application deadline and one month before departure: refund of tuition fee only (full fee paying PRINCH students). 50% refund of the fee paid (Ministry of Education funded students).
- Withdrawal within one month before departure: no refund.
- CLC/CUHK reserves the right to re-arrange activity schedule due to academic considerations and to change accommodation arrangements (with similar conditions) due to change of situation.

#### **Liabilities**

CLC/CUHK shall not under any circumstances be liable, in contract, tort or otherwise, for any of the expenses, damages or losses incurred or sustained by any students which arise from or as a result of the delay or cancellation of any scheduled transportation. PRINCH is founded by the CLC director and the programme team which has been launched since 2006. It has been a successful program because of its distinctive features: Learning through application; Small group enhancement exercise; Task based and proficiency oriented; Valuable visits etc. We are dedicated to provide students with a rewarding and fruitful PRINCH experience.

To these ends, all participants' photos, audio/ video/ written records, questionnaires taken during the course are of extreme significance in PRINCH with regard to course teaching, management and administration, as well as assessment. For example, head teacher may give individual feedbacks on individual presentations based on the recordings which could not have been done one by one in class.
