There are wonderful illustrations, and good examples. Professor Hedley speaks clearly and keeps to the point. This will be a very engaging introduction to epidemiology. Perhapsthe link with non-infectious diseases could be made more strongly. At times, the user might be given the impression that epidemiology is a discipline that tackles only infectious diseases. Of course the examples that are given, and the principles that are covered, are just as relevant to the study of health problems resulting from environmental toxins or physical hazards or diet. The CD also reminded me how Europocentric the standard histories of epidemiology are. Established human settlement has a much longer history outside Europe than within. As mentioned on the CD, conditions like the plague were known in the great cities of India and China well before the epidemics of the middle ages in Europe. How did these civilisations respond? China for instance had traditions of systematic record-keeping, literacy and scientific thinking long before these things were established in Europe. Surely there must be things we could learn from their attempts at disease control. But nothing of this kind appears in the standard texts.
