Using MOOCs for Institutional Collaboration

Abstract

Since joining Coursera and edX three years ago, HKUST has offered 10 MOOCs to over 400,000 students from around the world. In this talk, I will share HKUST's experience in using MOOCs for blended learning courses on campus. I will also discuss the opportunities of using MOOC as a platform for inter-institutional collaboration in both education and research. In particular, I will discuss projects that make use of the vast amount of data collected from MOOCs for improving the delivery of teaching and enhancing the learning experience of students.
