Mission & Objectives

The JD / MBA programme will combine, in an integrated postgraduate double-degree structure, an academically rigorous and professionally enriching programme of legal and business studies which will equip its graduates with the education and skills required for leadership in Hong Kong, China and Asia.

Degrees earned: Both a Juris Doctor (JD) degree and a Master of Business

Administration (MBA) degree

Study modes : Full Time mode & Part Time mode

Normative Study periods: 3 academic years for Full Time (maximum period 5

years)

5 academic years for Part Time (maximum period 7.5

years)

Entry requirements:

Applicants for admission to the JD/MBA Programme must have:

- Academic
 - a Bachelor's degree normally with honours not lower than Second Class; or an average grade of not lower than "B" in undergraduate courses; or
 - completed a course of study in a tertiary educational institution and obtained professional or similar qualifications equivalent to an honours degree.
- GMAT scores and English Language Proficiency Requirement
- Work Experience
 - For Full time programme: 3 years' post-qualification full-time work experience or recognized professional qualifications are expected;
 - For Part time programme: At least 3 years' post-qualification full-time work experience or recognized professional qualifications
