### 1. Project objectives

This project aims to restructure the course content in the Blackboard for some of my profession sport skills teaching courses and develop a YouTube "Professional Sports Skill Teaching Channel". The courses are SPED 3220 (Teaching Alternative sports), SPED 2211 (Teaching Gymnastics) and the course of SPED 3250 (Teaching Social Dance and Folk Dance).

There are over 133 videos/micro-modules have been uploaded and used by our students/or public. The number of the teaching videos are as follows:

#### The schedule of the micro-modules for my teaching courses:

The duration of this project has been extended from January 2017 to May 2017, the end of 2016-17 second term. Because our department did not provide some of the elective teaching courses during the original project schedule. After the extension of the project, I am happy to say that the implementation of the use of teaching materials/videos for the Rock climbing course (SPED 3220A) as well as the Teaching gymnastics (SPED 2211) course have been evaluated. The results show that the number of visits for those teaching videos are over thousands. #### **3. Evaluation Plan**

The micro-modules/ teaching content will be mainly used by the related course students in the original design of the project. Students have encouraged to review the related teaching videos before and after the course. Moreover, they also can review the teaching videos during the group activities and practices in the teaching course. Our department has offered the course of "SPED 3220, Alternative sports: Teaching Sports Climbing" and the course of "SPED 2211 Teaching Gymnastics: Theory and Practice" in the first and second semester 2016-2017, respectively. Students' learning process have been recorded.

However, our department did not offer the elective course of SPED 3250 (Teaching Social Dance and Folk Dance: Theory and Practice) during the project schedule, the use of those teaching videos can only be showed by the number of visits. For example, the figure 1 shows that some of the Folk Dance teaching videos have over thousands of visits.
