1. Project objectives

The project was proposed to design six micro-modules with flipped classroom approach for the target course "Information Technology in Education" offered by the Faculty of Education. The objectives of this project are to support and promote the university eLearning strategy especially to practice flipped classroom pedagogical approach. Up to this moment, we have developed three full teaching packages including the lecture videos and corresponding teaching material e.g. ppt and the progress matches quite well with the proposed schedule. To refine the topics and align with the most updated educational issues in this course. We have revised the titles of certain topics. The topic of "design and implication of online quiz" would be rephrased to "eLearning design and implementation" to address the importance of eLearning rather than online quiz design. And the topic of "audio production for teaching and learning" would be replaced by "eTextbook in education". The reason for changing the topic is to reflect the course updating as eTextbook becomes a worldwide hot issue in the field of education. So, the revised topics covered in this project will include 1) ubiquitous learning; 2) eLearning design and implementation 3) flipped classroom approach; 4) digital storytelling; 5) eTextbook in education; and 6) WebQuest design.

2. Progress on process, outcomes or deliverables

Three modules have been fully accomplished so far including Digital Storytelling, eTextbook in education and eLearning design and implementation. Annotated ppt for these topic were recorded with bilingual version for students with sets of learning materials. In the coming months before end of October 2016, we will finish all other three modules according to the proposed timeline. And the project would be successfully completed before the grant expiry date.

Project outputs to date:

1) Six modules of videos for flipped classroom: end of October 2016

2) Course website for student learning with learning resources developed by the project: end of December, 2016
