The videotaping of the lectures has almost finished. It is expected that 2 of the micro-modules will be ready for use by this summer. With the help from the Centre for eLearning innovation and Technology (ELITE), the production procedure of all the micro-modules, including

videotaping and editing, will be complete for the foundation course UGFH1000 *In Dialogue* with Humanity. A video clip with incorporation of interactive study questions is being produced. The project will be on time for completion and the first micro-modules will be available at the beginning of Term 1, 2016-17 as planned.

#### 3. Evaluation Plan

Our evaluation plan has the following elements:

- 1. Online survey: students users will be asked to review the lectures after they have done the interactive quiz
- 2. Analysis of web-log: The use of online platform by students will be monitored. KEEP can track the number of users, location of users, duration of time they spend, etc.
- 3. Focus group interviews: at least two focus group interviews (one in Term 2, 2015-16, and the other in Term 1, 2016-17) will be conducted to seek students' feedback.
