1. Project objectives

In this project, we aim to develop 4 micro-modules for the major topics in the Anatomy course (NURS1403) offered to Year 2 Nursing students to enhance students' understanding of the human anatomical structures and arrangement. The micro-modules is expected to help students consolidate the knowledge learnt and apply them into nursing clinical practice.

Due to some staff movement, the topics selected for developing the micro-modules have been changed from the proposed "The Musculoskeletal system" and "The Cardio-Respiratory system", to "The Musculoskeletal system" and "The Nervous system". This change will not affect the objectives of this project and the topics selected is also an important topic in the course.

Overall, the project is on track to meet its objectives and have not been changed.

2. Progress on process, outcomes or deliverables

All 4 micro-modules have been developed and used in Flipped Classroom Teaching between September - October 2017. Each micro-module lasted for approximately 20 minutes and contains tailored made video/ animations on course contains, followed by some questions for self-evaluation. So far, we did not encounter a lot of obstacles as the production process was quite smooth and we are confident that the remaining tasks can be completed on time.

3. Evaluation Plan

As indicated in the application, we plan to adopt the following strategies to evaluate students' experience in using micro-modules:

Student surveys : A written survey will be collected at the end of the course.
