**1. Project objectives**

The project is on track to meet all objectives. The footage for six micromodules has been filmed and the initial editing has been completed along with the associated electronic assessment materials. The objectives have not changed and remain the same as the initial grant application with a more clear emphasis on which communication skills are more essential for the degree programs enrolled in this course.

**2. Progress on process, outcomes or deliverables**

So far the following items have been accomplished:

1. Scripts have been written
2. All videos and principle photography have been filmed in various settings
3. Questions incorporated into courseware have been written.
4. Initial editing of videos has been performed.

Remaining tasks include:

1. Finalized editing of the videos and implementation of Chinese subtitles
2. Initial pilot testing on some students to gather feedback on how to make some improvements to optimize the micromodules for initial rollout in 2018-2019 Term 2

The project is on schedule for a timely completion in October 2018.

The course for which this micromodule has been developed is offered in the 2<sup>nd</sup> term of year

so with the deadline of the grant completion, this micromodule will not be able to be rolled out on a full scale until January of 2019 when the class is offered again.
