Why new learning spaces?

- 3000 extra new students + double cohort
- Changing curriculum demands KBE and 3+3+4
- Skills required: effective communication, computing and Internet skills, independent and interdependent learning, entrepreneurial skills, ability to take the initiative, be flexible, work in teams and network – as well as the usual subject matter expertise
- Changing student demographics (younger), increased numbers and diversity, a 'community' space for non-resident students
- New opportunities, new buildings, new technologies

- A place to get advice & help on project development, etc








Warwick University 'Learning Grid'









Figure 6: Case-based presentation layout




