This talk reviews the interest and responses of Hong Kong's new generations to the business sector and government's initiatives in promoting youth entrepreneurship in the Greater Bay Area (GBA). The speaker will augment his observations with information from young entrepreneurs who joined the CUHK "MAKE a DASH" programme. This programme has received governmental sponsorship and societal support to land youth entrepreneurs in GBA. The talk will draw on the views of the participants, review the consequences of the programme, and discuss how Hong Kong youth entrepreneurship is deployed in GBA.
