

ERRATA FOR JCL 16.2 (JUNE 1988)

On page 346, line 6: '... right to left ...' should read '... left to right, top to bottom ...'

On page 347, line 8: 'are' should be inserted before 'not'.

On page 347, line 15 on, the following text was missing: The verb copying that often accompanies the use of a durational complement is sensitive to the aspectual structure of the verb rather than its syntactic characteristics: if the verb is telic, there is no copying; if it is atelic, there is copying. The aspectual value of a verb is a function of the whole phrase or clause, as the degree of definiteness of the object can affect the aspect of the verb.
