II. Update on Panel Discussion on Archaic Chinese Phonology

Professor Jerry Norman has notified us that he will not be able to attend the panel discussion on Archaic Chinese because of other commitments in Japan. The organization of the panel will be revised as the following:

The duration of the panel will be shortened to roughly two and a half hours and the time for discussion from the floor will be lengthened to forty (40) minutes. Each panelist will have thirty (30) minutes to present his position

on the phonological system of Archaic Chinese, and each commentator will have twenty (20) minutes to comment. Each panelist may have five additional minutes to respond to the comments. Please let us know your suggestions with regard to this panel discussion. We encourage submission of original papers on Archaic Chinese.
