The Postgraduate Diploma Programme in Critical Care Nursing is designed to equip registered nurses currently working in intensive care units or paediatric and neonatal intensive care units with advanced knowledge and skills needed to maintain high standard of specialized care for critically ill patients.

Programme Structure and Duration

The programme consists of 16 units and it could be completed within 1 year. It is divided into two concentration streams: (1) Intensive Care and (2) Paediatric and Neonatal Intensive Care. There are 8 units of core courses and 8 units of concentration elective courses.



Medium of Instruction

English will be used as medium of instruction.

Venue

Courses will be held at Prince of Wales Hospital or The Chinese University of Hong Kong campus.

Mode of Delivery

Courses will be delivered on Wednesday and/or Friday daytime and evening.

Admission Requirements

Applicant should

- 1. fulfill general requirements of the CUHK Graduate School; and
- 2. be a registered nurse with the Nursing Council of Hong Kong; or with a recognized equivalent qualification; and
- 3. be a nurse with a minimum of one year post registration experience and is currently working in the intensive care unit of paediatric and neonatal intensive care unit.

Unit Exemption

Graduates from Diploma Programme in Critical Care Nursing (Intensive Care/ Paediatric and Neonatal Intensive Care) (CUHK) could apply for unit exemption of concentration elective courses. Other equivalent qualifications could also be considered.

Information Technology (IT) Proficiency Requirements

All students are required to pass the IT Proficiency Test before they graduate. Students who have passed the IT Proficiency Test at another CUHK programme will be exempted.



Graduation Requirements

In order to graduate, student must:

- 1. have an attendance rate of 80% or above in each courses; and
- 2. pass all assessments in each course; and
- 3. obtain a cumulative overall GPA of at least 2.0.

CNE Accreditation

224 CNE points will be offered for whole programme.

Programme Fee

Programme fee for 2011 intake is HK\$45,344 for 16 units.
