After holding the Organ Scholarship at Hatfield College, University of Durham, from whence Peter graduated, he went for post-graduate studies to The Royal College of Music, London.

Appointments in UK included Director of Music at Wrekin College, and Organist of Portsmouth Cathedral. For 27 years he was also a world-wide examiner for The Royal Schools of Music, visiting HK several times. From 1979 he was Organ Tutor at Chung Chi College for seven years, and conductor of the HK Bach Choir and the HK Chamber Orchestra. Since his return to the UK, Peter has been a visiting university lecturer in Zimbabwe, and continued giving recitals in UK and Overseas, including New Zealand and the Philippines. Most recently in HK he gave a joint concert with HK pianist, Stephen Wong, in the Cultural Centre on the evening of 18th May, 2003.
