F F Poon

F F Poon is an oncologist by profession. She started her vocal training in her medical student days. Studying under Maestro Elisio Gualdi, majoring in Italian opera and bel canto she obtained her LRSM in Singing (Performance) and performed many leading roles in locally produced operas. After the retirement of Maestro Gualdi she turned to the German and French art song repertoire and was coached by visiting masters Désiré Ligeti and Peter Wöss.

F F Poon is well known for her rendition of art songs and operatic arias as well as church music. She gives recitals regularly in academic institutions, concert halls and over the radio and appears frequently as soloist with local choruses and orchestras. She is particularly active in charity concerts. Her fundraising performances locally and abroad have benefited many worthy causes.

Li, Geoff-Erik

Li, Geoff-Erik, studied the piano in Baptist University under the tutelage of Mr Chong Hung and attained the LTCL Performer's Diploma with distinction and won a scholarship to further his studies in the University of Cincinnati under Dr William Black. On coming back to Hong Kong he won the Jackie Chan Scholarship for 2 consecutive years and studied in the HK Academy for Performing Arts under Mr Gabriel Kwok.

Erik has been very active as a solo pianist and an accompanist, performing frequently in Hong Kong, Taiwan and Mainland China, and working regularly with violinist Yao Jue and soprano F F Poon. Recently he also took part in the performance of The Phantom of the Opera as an orchestral keyboard player.
