## **HO HONG YING & EVA LUE**

Ho Hong-ying and Eva Lue performed together back in 1990. They find time to play together again in recent months amidst their busy schedule of performances, teaching and family duties. They each have two children. Hong-ying Ho was born in canton, China and began to study the violin at the age of 7 and at 11 entered the central conservatory as an exceptional student. During her school years in Beijing she performed for many world renowned violinists and professors such as Isaac Stern, Yehudi Menuhin and Dorothy Delay. With Ms. Delay's recommendation she entered the Juilliard School of Music in 1984 and completed her Master's degree in 1990.

Ho was a winner and prize winner of the Chinese National Violin Competition at age 14, Menuhin International Violin Competition at 16, and New York Youth Symphony Concerto Competition, Bergen Philharmonic Concerto Competition, National Arts Club Violin Competition, and Artist International (New York) Presentations during her years at the Juilliard School. As a result of these competitions she was presented in concerts in Carnegie Hall and Weill Recital Hall.

Ho is an active chamber musician who has been members of the Manhattan String Trio, Manhattan Piano Trio and since 1995 the Bauhinia Piano Trio. She is currently teaching at the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts and the Yip's music center.

Hong Kong born pianist Eva Lue received musical training from the Royal College of Music, London, being the recipient of scholarships and prizes. Since returning home to Hong Kong, Eva Lue has appeared as concerto soloist with the Hong Kong Philharmonic Orchestra, Hong Kong Chinese Orchestra and the Hong Kong Sinfonietta Orchestra. Her recitals and radio broadcasts both as soloist and accompanist were welcomed with critical acclaim. She is at present piano staff at the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts.
