*Tempest in a Teacup* creates a musical blending of Canadian and Chinese culture, not through harmonic or rhythmic cultural markers, but rather through that one addiction, comfort and social binder that both countries love: Tea. Composer and librettist Dean Burry was born in St. John's, Newfoundland but grew up in the town of Gander. Burry is currently a professor at the Glenn Gould Professional School of the Royal Conservatory of Music and pursuing a DMA at the University of Toronto.

In *Broken Images*, three large-scale sonic images are presented in constant flux. Embedded within these larger sections are increasingly complex deeper level sonic events that are experienced from a variety of angles. The narrative potential of these musical events is constantly interrupted. This process continues as earlier events (or later events) are given their conclusion later (or earlier) in the piece.
