3) Programme Information

- The National Cheng Kung University WUN Virtual Summer School is an additional programme of the Virtual Summer Programmes 2022.
- Date: 8 18 August 2022
- Format: Virtual
- Language: All courses are offered in English
- Available Courses: Under the theme of "Act for Sustainability," nine sessions will address issues which correlate to specific UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

- Students should pay attention to the following when applying for the programme:
 - Students who are expected to graduate on 31 July 2022 (as of 10 May on CUSIS) are not eligible to join;
 - Class meeting dates and time. Classes of the programme will take place in the afternoons and evenings at Hong Kong time. This programme offers synchronous classes and requires real-time participation by students in classes; and
 - o Interests in the courses offered by the programme.

4) Completing a Webform for Application

 Interested students must complete and submit a <u>webform</u> from 29 April 2022 (09:00) to 9 May 2022 (23:59).

5) Placement Allocation

- Applications submitted according to the instructions will be processed by OAL. Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered.
- Quotas are limited in the programme. Eligible students would be provided an offer, if any, according to their expected graduation date, previous participation in non-local learning programmes offered by CUHK and cumulative GPA (CGPA) as of 10 May 2022.
- Applications from eligible students who could not participate in term-time outgoing exchanges as planned in 2021-22 due to COVID-19 (Group 1)¹ will be considered before other students (Group 2). In each group, students meeting the following criteria² will be given priority in placement allocation.
 - 1. Have not participated in any non-local learning programmes offered by CUHK units (as of 10 May 2022);
 - 2. Have an earlier expected graduation date (as of 10 May 2022) on CUSIS;
 - 3. Have a higher CGPA as of 10 May 2022; and
 - 4. Have not received any offer of non-local learning programmes from CUHK units in the past or for future.

Should there be multiple eligible applicants with the same expected graduation date, previous non-local learning experience and CGPA, OAL will draw lots to provide offers among those students.

- Students who have accepted an offer from the Virtual Summer Programmes 2022 selection took place in March/April 2022 will not be offered a place from this exercise.
- Placement results will be announced on 11 May 2022 via email.

6) Deposit and Tuition/Programme Fee

- Successful applicants will be sponsored to participate in the selected virtual summer programme. These students do not need to pay any tuition/programme fee to the host institution, but they have to complete and submit a Virtual Summer Programme Nomination Deposit Form to OAL by 13 May 2022.
- After completion of the programme, students must by 30 September 2022 submit to OAL a transcript or a certificate of completion issued by the host institution; otherwise, a nomination deposit of HK\$1,500 will be charged.
- Students may apply to the host institution directly, i.e. not applying through OAL. However, they will be required to pay to the host institution the tuition or programme fee.

¹ Group 1 students who have refused an offer in the Virtual Summer Programmes 2022 selection will not be given priority in this selection exercise.

² Sequence of the listed criteria matters.
