

NANZAN UNIVERSITY CENTER FOR JAPANESE STUDIES (CJS)
VISITING FACULTY PROGRAM
SPRING (Jan.-May 2017).

The Nanzan University Center for Japanese Studies (CJS) has established a Visiting Faculty Program to strengthen collaborative efforts with its student exchange partner schools. Every year, Nanzan University will invite from among its exchange partner schools one faculty member in the field of Japanese Area Studies to teach and conduct research under the following conditions.

VISITING FACULTY MEMBER'S OBLIGATIONS:

- 1) The Visiting Faculty Member will teach at least one course in Japanese Area Studies (literature, culture, history, politics, economics, business, international relations, etc), at Nanzan University CJS in semester, Spring (January-May, 2017), during his/her period of stay. The area studies courses will be taught in English.
- 2) The Visiting Faculty Member is expected to use the stay at Nanzan to continue his or her own research and engage in scholarly dialog with Nanzan University faculty members, and is encouraged to participate in CJS and University activities.

NANZAN UNIVERSITY WILL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) 1,500,000 yen stipend for travel and living expenses. Please note that accommodation will not be provided by Nanzan University but will be the responsibility of the visiting scholar. Information on apartments or other possible housing options will be provided if requested.
However, please note that the stipend will be 1,193,700 yen net, with 306,300 yen withheld as income tax for those who come from countries or regions that do not have tax treaties with Japan covering academic positions.
- 2) Remuneration for the course(s) taught (from 310,500 to 360,000 yen, for a typical three-credit hour course, depending on teaching experience and academic rank)
- 3) A faculty office with internet connection
- 4) Use of the Nanzan University Library

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

Those interested in applying to the program should submit the following documents to the address below by December 31, 2015.

- 1) A curriculum vitae including the applicant's educational and professional history.
- 2) A short description of the course(s) that the applicant could offer at Nanzan CJS.
- 3) A short description of current research interests and projects that could be carried out at Nanzan University.
- 4) A letter of recommendation from the applicant's department head.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Applicants may be contacted by e-mail or telephone to confirm the details of the application.

Applicants for the program will be screened by the Japanese Language and Area Studies Program Sub-Committee of the Center for International Education, recommended by the Center for International Education Committee for approval to the Nanzan University Senate, and finally appointed by the President of Nanzan University. Notification of acceptance will be given by the middle of May 2016.

NOTE: Applicants who have been selected and have completed the program are not eligible to apply again.
