- 4) **Course Load Requirement During Exchange**
 - ✧ For Undergraduates
 - Students in the new curriculum must enroll in a minimum of 9 units and obtain passing grades in at least 6 units of courses per term (or equivalent, except summer term).
 - Students in the old curriculum must enroll in a minimum of 12 units and obtain passing grades in at least 9 units of courses per term (or equivalent, except summer term).
 - Failure to comply with the aforementioned requirements may cause complications to the graduation and/or 100% repayment of financial support under the CUHK Student Exchange Financial Aid and Scholarship Scheme (FASS).
 - A statement worded 'a completed academic record of this degree programme should include the academic transcript(s) from the exchange partner(s) which can be provided separately by the student' will be printed on their CUHK transcript.

 - Students should enroll in a number of courses which meets the minimum course load requirement of their CUHK full-time postgraduate programme.
