2009 Administrative Service Student Summer Internship Programme

The Administrative Service Student Summer Internship Programme is now open for application. Selected students will be placed in different Government bureaux and departments as interns. The internship will last for approximately two months between June and August, during which interns would be offered a monthly allowance of \$7,000 (including contribution to Mandatory Provident Fund).

The Government is looking for students fulfilling the following criteria for participation in the programme:

- ☞ HKSAR Permanent Resident status;
- ☞ full-time students completing their bachelor's or postgraduate degree programmes in the summer of 2010;
- ☞ commitment to serve the community and an interest in pursuing a career in the Administrative Service after graduation;
- ☞ possession of leadership qualities;
- ☞ ability to work in a team;
- ☞ active participation in community/school activities;
- ☞ outstanding academic achievements; and
- ☞ good command of both Chinese and English

Owing to keen competition, applicants who are not able to attend the assessment centre will hardly be selected for nomination. If you do not hear from us within one week after the application deadline on 18 May, you may consider your application unsuccessful.

Students who are currently on exchange outside Hong Kong and will be graduating in the summer of 2010 should follow the application procedures of local students mentioned above. These applications will be considered on individual basis.
