Pilot Mentorship-Sibling Programme

Objectives

1. To promote mentoring relationships between academic staff and students (**local, mainland** and **international students**), and to encourage active participation by both parties.
2. To complete student integration of various cultural backgrounds on campus.
3. To provide platforms for academic staff and students to interact, exchange thoughts and share experiences.
4. To enhance students' educational, social and personal development through learning from the experience of mentors.
5. To build up and strengthen the relationships between students and the University.

Mentors' Roles and Responsibilities

1. Mentors may act as a coach by giving advice and guidance to the mentees about their adaptation to the life in Hong Kong, career planning and advancement in the future.
2. Mentors may help mentees gain wider exposure, enhance problem solving skills and enrich their social life through the programme.

Mentees' Roles and Responsibilities

1. Mentees can share their achievements, interests and issues in relation to their personal growth with the mentors.
2. Mentees can seek advice from mentors about academic development and career planning.

Matching

1. Each group consists of a mentor who is expected to take up a group of mentees comprising of local, mainland, international students, in order to facilitate communication.
2. The background, aspiration, preference, and etc. of the two parties will be matched to ensure the successful establishment of relationship.
