### Internationalization Activity Fund 2015-16

#### Purpose

The Internationalization Activity Fund aims to support students to organize activities which promote internationalization and inter-cultural exchange opportunities among members of the University community.

#### Eligibility

All registered undergraduate and postgraduate student associations are eligible for applying for financial support from the Fund.

Student bodies (including ad hoc student groups/individuals) representing non-local ethnic or regional origins are encouraged to apply for the funding to organize activities for promoting campus integration and cohesion.

#### Assessment Criteria

- ☞ Consideration will be given to the overall merits of each application, including innovation and impact of the activity in enhancing the internationalization exposures of students outside the association concerned.
- ☞ Priority will be given to activities which involve a larger number of students, whether as participants or organizers.
- ☞ Inter-association collaboration will be highly encouraged.
- ☞ The maximum amount of support for each application is capped at \$20,000.
