Resident Regulations – Main Points to Note

1. Residents should **not** possess, store or consume hard liquor (alcohol content over 30%) in any forms in the premises of the Hostel.
2. Drunkenness and related disorderly behaviors are regarded as misbehaviors.
3. Smoking is prohibited in the **entire University campus** (including all indoor and outdoor areas of the Hostel).
4. Gambling in any forms and possession of any gambling facilities (including, but not limited to, Mahjong) are prohibited.
5. The volume of audio systems should be kept low. The period between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. is regarded as the Quiet Hours of the Hostel. Any resident who during the Quiet Hours makes or causes to be made any noise which is a source of annoyance to any person commits an offence.
6. **Visiting Hours of the Hostel** - Monday to Sunday: 7:00 a.m. – 12:00 midnight
Visitors are **not** allowed in the hostel between 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m., except personnel permitted by the Warden. No persons (including residents) are allowed to enter the floor of the opposite sex except during visiting hours.
7. Residents are **not** allowed to exchange their rooms without the Warden's express permission.
8. Residents are **not** allowed to duplicate the keys. If there are problems with the keys, please report to the Management Office.
9. Hostel properties should be handled with care. Residents should **not** interfere with or deface existing fixtures, fittings and furniture. In case of damage or lost, compensations are to be made by the residents concerned according to the values of the damaged / lost properties.

Declaration

I declare that I have read the above main points of the International House Resident Regulations. I understand that a resident breaking any of the Resident Regulations or University Regulations will be subject to the University's Disciplinary Regulations and may be censured or reprimanded by the Warden, or be referred to the International House Management Committee (and his/her respective College's Disciplinary Committee, if applicable) for consideration of expulsion from the Hostel and revocation of the right to apply for future residence.
