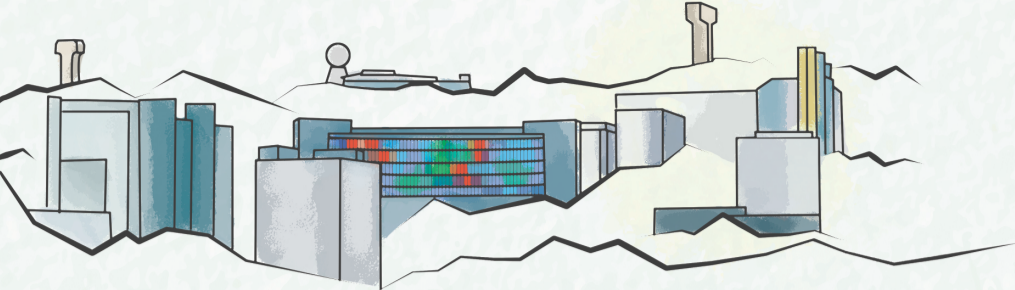

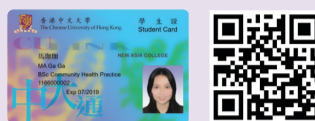

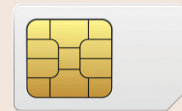

## Bank Account Opening 銀行開戶



There are two banks on campus: Hang Seng Bank (1/F, John Fulton Centre) and the Bank of East Asia (1/F, Pommerenke Student Centre).

Documents required (students under 18 should be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian):

- Passport or EEP (往來港澳通行證),
- National Identity Card,
- CU Link Card or admission letter,
- Student visa and landing slip,
- Hong Kong Identity Card (if any),
- Proof of your address in home country, and
- Proof of residency in Hong Kong (get one from your college if you reside on campus)

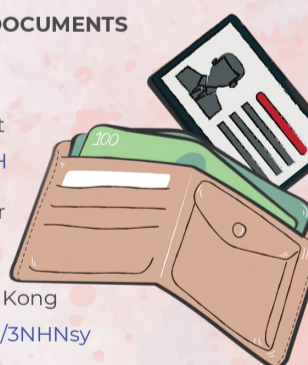
