

There are two banks on campus: Hang Seng Bank (1/F, John Fulton Centre) and the Bank of East Asia (1/F, Pommerenke Student Centre).

Documents required (students under 18 should be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian):

- a. Passport or EEP (往來港澳通行證),
- b. National Identity Card,
- c. CU Link Card or admission letter,
- d. Student visa and landing slip,
- e. Hong Kong Identity Card (if any),
- f. Proof of your address in home country, and
- g. Proof of residency in Hong Kong (get one from your college if you reside on campus)


