Documents and Information Required for Opening Personal Account

Please bring along the Original copy of the following documents to any of our branches for account application.

- (i) Passport or EEP 港澳通行證 (original and photocopy of both front and back sides)
- (ii) National Identity Card (original and photocopy of both front and back sides)
- (iii) CU Link Card or Admission Letter (original and photocopy)
- (iv) Proof of your address in home country
- (v) Proof of residency in Hong Kong (can be obtained from your college if you reside on campus), and
- (vi) Student visa and landing slip (original)

Students under 18:

Their parent or legal guardian should be physically present during the bank account opening and should bring along originals and photocopies of their National Identity Card and Passport or EEP.

Remarks:

1. It is required by the Hong Kong Government that for cash deposit over HK\$100,000, extra proof on withdrawal from bank in home countries (such as bank statement, transfer notice or deposit book) should be provided.
