## What is **SSeedS**?

Co-organised with Caritas St. Joseph Secondary School (CSJSS), the Student Development and Resources Section, Office of Student Affairs, organises a service project called **"Shadowing Scheme for Secondary Students (SSeedS)"**. SSeedS aims to:

- 1) make friends;
- 2) provide an opportunity for CUHK students to serve the community as peer mentors;
- 3) introduce concepts of everyday leadership;
- 4) develop a service-mind set;
- 5) enhance students' generic competencies of innovative problem solving, communication and teamwork through service learning; and
- 6) understand yourself, your team and help them flourishing.

**SSeedS** also creates a platform for members to practice how to be an everyday leader. Both **SSeedS** members (the peer mentors) and the secondary students can benefit through life on life interaction.
