Part I. Student Agreement to CUHK International Summer School Terms and Conditions

This document sets out the Terms and Conditions for _____

1. The student will comply with all regulations and requirements of the CUHK International Summer School and CUHK. The student understands that breach of these may cause the termination of his/her studies at CUHK without refund of fees.
2. The student understands that CUHK reserves the right to cancel or alter any part of the CUHK International Summer School should unforeseen circumstances make it advisable. CUHK shall not be liable for any loss resulting from such cancellation or change.
3. The student understands that course prerequisites at CUHK must be met and that course registration is based on availability of offerings and cannot be guaranteed.
4. The student understands the financial terms and arrangements of the CUHK International Summer School as outlined on the invoice, and is aware that CUHK reserves the right to amend the fees as necessary.
5. The student should carry adequate medical insurance for both his/her stay in Hong Kong and travels outside Hong Kong.
6. The student will be responsible for all costs arising out of his/her voluntary withdrawal from the CUHK International Summer School prior to its completion, including withdrawal caused by illness or disciplinary action.
7. The student realizes that any falsification or distortion in his/her application or subsequent correspondence with CUHK International Summer School authorities will be grounds for the termination of his/her studies at CUHK, together with automatic loss of all fees.
8. The student will authorize his/her home university and CUHK to reproduce and/or release any and all portions of his/her application and related documentation to the Hong Kong Immigration Department for visa application and for purposes relating to his/her study in accordance with the procedures of CUHK.
