Transportation to CUHK

The Chinese University of Hong Kong is located in Shatin, the New Territories, and is easily reached from the Hong Kong International Airport by a combination of ground transportation. There are several ways to travel from the HK International Airport to CUHK:

By Taxi:

The trip from the airport to the University is about 45 minutes. Normally, the fare is about HK\$350. Most taxi drivers in Hong Kong know some English. For your convenience we have made available the names of CUHK and residence hall in Chinese and English characters for you to download (http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/osp/pdf/SI_AccAdd2016.pdf) and show to the taxi driver if needed.

* Note: New Century Cab provides pre-arranged airport pickup service. For arrangements, please call Mr. Chan at (852) 8106-6175 at least 2 hours before your flight leaves for HK.

By Airport Bus and Mass Transit Railway (MTR)

Take airport bus route number A41 from the airport to the Shatin Central Bus Terminal (Shatin New Town Plaza). The bus runs from 06:00 to 24:00 at 20-minute intervals. The bus ride takes 65 - 70 minutes depending on traffic conditions. The fare is HK\$ 22.3 payable on boarding bus in exact change.

Connected by:

- Taxi

From the Shatin Station, you can take a taxi to the Wu Yee Sun College, CUHK. The fare is about HK\$100. It will take about 15 minutes.

- MTR Train (Not recommended if you have bulk luggage)

Alternatively, from Shatin Station, you can take the train to University Station (second stop from Shatin). The trains run every 3 to 8 minutes from 05:30 to 24:30. The train ride takes about 9 minutes. The fare is HK\$4.

Upon exiting University Station, you should get off at Exit D (the 1st compartment of the train will be the nearest). There is a university shuttle bus stop on the opposite side of the station exit (outside Yasumoto International Academic Park). Please take route no. 3 and get off at "Residences 3 & 4".
