<Policy on Equal Opportunities>

As a caring University, CUHK seeks to promote a positive learning environment for its students and is committed to offering equal opportunities in academic pursuits for students with disabilities in accordance with the Disability Discrimination Ordinance.

<Types of Disabilities>

According to the Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS), the term "disability" refers to the following types of disabilities:

- Attention deficit / hyperactivity disorder
- Autism
- Hearing impairment
- Mental illness
- Physical handicap
- Specific learning difficulties
- Speech impairment
- Visceral disability
- Visual impairment

<Role of Office of Student Affairs>

- Act as first point of contact for full-time students with disabilities (with the 'Disability Services Coordinator' as the designated staff)
- Collect and screen relevant information & certification regarding a student's disability
- Assess the student's needs for accommodation owing to his/her disability
- Liaise & coordinate with relevant parties (Colleges, departments, units, etc.) on service provision
- Promote disability awareness within campus community
- Provide secretarial support to the Disability Services Coordinating Committee
- Offer learning enhancement service for full-time non-local students
- Offer psychological counselling service
- Offer career counselling service

To enable full-time disabled students to actively participate in campus life and to facilitate their learning, the following special services and facilities can be arranged according to individual needs:

- Hostel accommodation
- Access to buildings
- Access to library facilities

- Access to computer & IT facilities
- Learning aids & equipment
- Special lecture or exam arrangements
- General medical care
- Psychological counselling
- Career counselling
- Academic advisory

- Colleges (student hostel & College life)
- Faculties/ Departments (academic matters)
- Estates Management Office (special facilities management & installation in buildings)
- Information Technology Services Centre (IT support)
- Office of Academic Links (support for exchange students)

- Registration and Examinations Section (special exam arrangement for centralized examinations)
- Security and Transport Office (campus-round rehabilitation bus service)
