

Workshops on Preventing Sexual Harassment on Campus

Two workshops on preventing sexual harassment on campus were organized by the Committee Against Sexual Harassment in collaboration with the Equal Opportunities Commission (EOC) in Esther Lee Building on 6 May 2008. In the morning session, a talk on “Preventing Sexual Harassment on Campus” was conducted by Ms. Cynthia Lam, Senior Training Officer of the EOC. She was invited to share with the participants her expertise and best practices, taking into account the provisions of the Sex Discrimination Ordinance. 80 staff from various departments/units attended the talk. Participants were particularly excited to have the opportunity to raise practical issues for discussion during the Q & A session. The responses were very encouraging.

In the afternoon session, a tailor-made workshop on “Handling Sexual Harassment Complaints – Case Study Approach” was conducted for members of Panel Against Sexual Harassment. Practical cases were discussed and Ms. Cynthia Lam shared with the participants her hands-on experience in resolving sexual harassment complaints.
