- (b) Ensure all doors, including those of rooms inside the apartment, and all windows are locked and properly secured.
- (c) Please move TV sets, AV equipment and other expensive electronic items to rooms where you can lock them up.
- (d) Request your neighbours to keep watch for you.

We would also like to appeal for your assistance in reporting to us (Tel: 2609-7999) any out of the ordinary incidents, for example:

- (a) Suspected persons found loitering.
- (b) Uncommon knocking or tapping at doors and windows.
- (c) Unauthorized visits of workmen.
- (d) Visits of salesman and hawkers.
- (e) Intruders spotted.
- (f) Suspected removal of electronic appliances, or tampering of private cars.
- (g) Suspected cars found in residential area.
- (h) Any other matters you find suspicious.
