

Notes for Application Form Filling for Student Hostel Places 2009/10

1. The form must be filled in English.
2. There are a total of 2 pages. Please fill in the appropriate code on page 1.
3. For applicants applying for “special quota” on item A of page 1, please refer to appendix 1 and fill in appropriate code. For other applicants, please fill in the code of “Not applicable”.
4. For item B on page 1, please refer to appendix 2 for coding.
5. For item C, the total floor area is calculated in square feet (1 sq.m = 10.764 sq. ft). When filling in this information, please state how it is calculated and attach supporting documents. When total floor area is not available, it will be calculated by 90% of the saleable area.
6. For item D, please refer to appendix 4 for coding.
7. Documents to be submitted include:
 - (1) Proof of residential address e.g. notification letter or letters issued by the University or admission forms for JUPAS
 - (2) Proof of residential address of applicants’ parents or owner of the flat shared by the applicants (in case applicants do not live with parents), e.g. notification of voter registration, public rental housing tenancy agreement, demand for payment of rates, electricity, water or gas (telephone bills or statements from banks are not applicable)
 - (3) Proof of residential address of direct relatives living together
 - (4) Proof of residence area e.g. letter of proof by Estate Offices of Housing Department. For private properties, proof from Land Office, floor plan on agreements for sale and purchase of building units or sales brochure can be used (please state clearly how usable floor area is calculated).
 - (5) If health condition is listed as a reason of application, only proof from doctors of the University Health Service is accepted.
8. Should applicants fail to present proof required, marks of related parts will not be counted.
