

The Chinese University of Hong Kong Shaw College Student Hostels Check-Out Arrangement for the 2nd Term of 2016/2017

The final check-out date of Hostel Residence 2016/2017 is **22 May 2017 (Monday)**, **12 noon**. *All residents **MUST** perform check-out procedures <u>in person</u> at the hostel information counters (KMH: G01 / SHII: High Block 518) and leave the hostel during office hours by the final check-out date.

Office hours:

Monday to Friday 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Saturday 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 noon

Sunday and Public Holidays Closed

A. Check-out Procedures

- 1. <u>Before check-out</u>, residents should **remove all personal belongings in the room or storage** (i.e. wardrobes, bookshelf, drawers, etc.), clean and tidy up the space thoroughly and **restore the room to original condition**.
- 2. <u>During check-out</u>, residents should **return the keys** (including room keys and drawer keys) to hostel staff. **Hostel staff will inspect the rooms**. Should there be any damaged or lost hostel items, the charge incurred will be deducted from the hostel deposit.
- 3. <u>After room inspection</u>, in order to *confirm the check-out and arrange deposit refund, residents MUST return the below documents to the information counters:
 - "Confirmation of Room Inspection" (a slip provided by hostel staff after room inspection)
 - a copy of the **first page of the bank passbook** or the **debit card,** which clearly show the resident's **personal** <u>savings account</u> number

*Remarks:

- The above documents MUST BE returned to the information counters for confirming check-out. Otherwise, deposit refund cannot be arranged.
- A resident may authorize his/her agent to perform check-out for him/her. The agent is required to produce the resident's **Student ID copy** and **signed authorization letter** (in which the names and Student IDs of both the resident and the agent should be clearly stated).
- Hostel deposits will be <u>transferred</u> to <u>personal savings accounts of local banks</u> provided by residents. Non-local or non-savings bank accounts are not applicable. The bank holder MUST BE the resident himself/herself.
- Incoming exchange students are <u>not required</u> to submit copies of passbooks or debit cards, but are still <u>required</u> to go to information counters for confirming their check-out. Their hostel deposits will be refunded via the Office of Academic Links.

- Residents who are offered Period A of Summer Residence are required to <u>stay in their</u> <u>original hostel places on 22 May</u>, and <u>perform check-in and check-out procedures on 23</u> May for moving to the room for Summer Residence.

B. Luggage Storage

Residents who are offered hostel places in Summer Residence (Period B or C) or Hostel Residence 2017/2018 may store their luggage in the hostel and registration for luggage storage is required during check-out. Due to limited storage space, please note the below <u>limitations</u>:

- The size of each piece of luggage MUST be under 1 x 3 x 3 feet
- Local students may store one piece of luggage only. Non-local students may store up to two pieces of luggage
- **Summer Residents** and **Residents of Hostel Residence 2017/2018** MUST reclaim their luggage <u>within the respective check-in periods.</u>
- Personal items must be well packed inside suitcases or luggage bags, but valuable belongings should <u>not</u> be included. The College is not liable for any loss or damage. <u>Luggage will be discarded if they are not reclaimed within</u> the above-mentioned periods.

All check-out procedures MUST BE completed by 22 May, 12:00 noon. For those who do not perform check-out procedures by the stupilated deadline, their personal belongings will be discarded and the hostel deposit will not be refunded. If a resident need to stay in the hostel after the final check-out date due to very special reasons, he/she should apply to the Wardens and provide relevant supporting documents by 5 May (please complete the form at hostel information counters and submit the supporting documents). Residents who are approved to extend their stay (at most for one-week) will be charged at HK\$62 per day. However, residents who are not approved for extension are required to check out by the stipulated deadline.
