- 2.2 Living Conditions 40 marks
- 2.3 Living District 40 marks
- 2.4 For those who have committed serious offence (e.g. received 2 warning letters from warden) in 08/09, their applications will not be accepted in 09/10. For ordinary case offenders (e.g. received 1 warning letters from warden), 10% of marks will be deducted accordingly.
- 2.5 Additional 10 marks will be given to Year 3 or above students who have never lived in hostels.
