Step 1. Fill out and submit your application at



Step 2. Print out the [Confirmation Slip](#) after submitting the online application.

Step 3. To confirm your application, you need to pay a deposit of HK\$300 for each course that you have applied for. Please make the payment via HSBC or Hang Seng Bank ATM machines to the following Hang Seng Bank account and get a Payment Advice slip for record:

Step 4. Submit the [\(1\) Confirmation Slip](#) and [\(2\) Payment Advice slip](#) to the Dean of Students' Office by the deadline. Your application is then considered complete.

Important Notes:

1. *Students are not advised to pay the deposit at Hang Seng Bank branches using counter service, as a service charge of HK\$40 will be incurred and borne by students.*
2. *The deposit is only refundable in two conditions:
(1) participants complete the course with $\geq 80\%$ attendance or
(2) the course is cancelled.*
3. *A Certificate of Attendance will be awarded to the participants who have completed the course.*
4. *Your name on the application form **MUST** be the same as the bank account holder, otherwise the refunding procedures could be problematic.*
5. *Applications will be accepted on a first-come-first-served basis.*
