Key Planning Issues

1. Enhancement of College Life

- Provide more communal spaces for non-residence students.
- Enhance identity to each college other than providing courtyards.
- Avoid over-loading the resources and facilities of the existing colleges, such as library, by the new colleges.
- Provide extra resources to the existing colleges if they are expected to support the new colleges.
- Consider to alter existing buildings to fit the overall enhancement plan.

Chung Chi College

- Avoid overloading Elisabeth Luce Moore Library if more teaching facilities and pedestrian routes to be planned in the area.

Shaw College

- Provide more amenity facilities in Shaw College.

New Colleges

- Avoid providing hostels only for the new colleges.

2. Venues for Academic & Recreational Activities

- Consider to provide some indoor learning commons for social gatherings apart from open courtyards.
- Consider expansion to the existing libraries if no new library will be built.

3. Creating a Pedestrian-Friendly Campus

- Consider to create a new MTR Station exit at the northern edge of the University Station platform to facilitate the pedestrian travelling to Central Campus.
- Review the west pedestrian link connecting MTR station to Central Campus as it is crowded.
- Avoid providing too many covered walkways that may disturb the natural scenery.
- Consider to provide trees as natural shading.

4. Conservation of Places with Cultural Significance

- Renovate some of the existing buildings to harmonize with the surrounding.

Other Issues

- Consider to provide better lighting, refreshment and internet services in the common areas.
- Elaborate the implementation plan of the CMP.
