

Questions/Comments raised by Council members, Senators and members of university committees on Preliminary Master Plan Proposal

Campus Organisation

1. Have the proposals taken into consideration the consistency of building designs?
2. Is the building of a new University Hall and Cultural Complex at the area adjacent to the current train station - a rare piece of flat land in the campus, justified (Andrew Lee's proposal)?
3. Does the proposed library next to the current train station mean demolition of the University Library (Andrew Lee's proposal)?
4. Is it possible to make use of the relatively underdeveloped and therefore uncontroversial areas adjacent to the train station to build a complex linking the current train station and the University's entrance at Tai Po Road?
5. Is it possible to focus on a circular network around area 39 rather than a linear pedestrian system?

Transportation

1. How long would it take to walk leisurely from KCRC station to New Asia College?
2. Would the proposed vehicle-free campus mean inconvenience and problems during emergencies (P & T's proposal)?
3. Does the consultant (Andrew Lee's proposal) have certainty that KCRC would approve the new train station?

Environment/Energy

1. Are mechanized and covered pedestrian walkways really green and natural?
