Master of Arts Programme in Cultural Management

Through classroom lectures and internship experiences, the Programme intends to equip students with critical, creative, technical and managerial skills so that they could be engaged in the professional practice of cultural management in Hong Kong and beyond. Students are expected to acquire the following skills and knowledge upon the completion of the Programme:

1. Critical ability

- Ability to engage in critical review of the various form of cultural expressions and provide distinctive interpretations;
- b. Ability to understand and critically review local and global cultural landscape in terms of their political and ecological context;
- c. Capable of being critical of traditional and existing practices in cultural management.

Creative skills

- a. Ability to curate distinctive cultural programmes with creative interpretation and presentation;
- b. Ability to introduce creative elements in communicating with the public through different mediation formats such as marketing, publication, education and outreach programming.

3. Technical and managerial know-how

- Management of various forms of cultural institutions, including arts centres, performing arts venues, museums, independent arts spaces, and arts and cultural organizations;
- b. Managing the production and presentation of cultural programmes, including various forms of performances, exhibition, film/video/digital arts presentation, community arts, and other arts projects;
- c. Providing mediation services for cultural programmes, including marketing, education programme and community outreach activities.
