Best Practices for Online Video

Best Practices for Online Video

- Keep It Short
 - TV: 8 min, Youtube 3 min, Vine 6 sec
- Engage early
 - Skip the intro!
 - Within 30 seconds you could lose 1/3 of your audience
- Make it Interactive
 - Use video of the speaker
 - Action for students (notes, quiz)
 - Ask questions



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

Screencapture

- Primary Video and audio
- Do you need computer audio?
 - Will you be playing video or audio from the computer that will not be recorded by your audio source?
- Capture Main Screen
- Mouse halo?




• Change computer properties to make mouse smoother /bigger?



Powerpoint capture

- Primary Video and audio
- Capture Powerpoint
- Choose presentation
- Decide when to start slides
- Do you also need screencapture?
 - Panopto only captures still slide images



• Panopto will not capture powerpoint transitions or animations

Best Practices for Recording Video

- Make sure you have a good microphone and then TALK INTO IT
- Practice speaking a few times before recording
- Tense the muscles in your face and release
- Wear solid colors
- Do one long take in Panopto and edit later

- Practice moving through the slides or content items before recording so there are no surprises and you can move smoothly on screen
- If you make a mistake, take a breath, clap or pause and unpause the recorder and start again from the beginning of your sentence

- Background and clothing
- Video and sound quality
- Delivery

No Such Thing as Too Much Light



Too dark

Harsh shadows

Just right

One or Two Lights?

One Light

Place the light behind or just above the camera.

Place each light to the side of the camera, angled in.

Clothing

Background

• Stick with solid colors

• Keep it as plain as possible

- Contrast shirt and background
- Blue is generally your friend

- Neutral gray works well
- Don't sit too close to background

Minimize Echo




Minimize Hum and Ambient Noise
