Echo 360 – What is it?

- It is a Lecture Recording System.
- Not an online broadcasting system.
- This is a pilot project jointly provided by ITSC and CLEAR.






Echo 360 – How it works?

- Once setup the system in a lecture theatre, we can then use it to record lecture video and/or audio automatically according to a pre-defined schedule.
- Once the recording is done, the recording can easily be transferred to LMS such as WebCT or Moodle or put it into podcast server or iTunes U















Echo 360 – Con't

- As a pilot project, three systems setup in the following location

- The Chinese University of Hong Kong joined Apple's iTunes U program in August 2010.
- With this latest initiative to promote knowledge transfer and lifelong learning, the University places a variety of educational programmes at the viewers' fingertips.





Via CUHK on iTunes U, users can:

- **Download** free faculty talks, presentations, videos and campus events.
- Play audio and video on PC or Mac or on mobile devices such as iPod/ iPhone/ iPad.

Mobile Learning – mLearning

- Background
- The University has been using three eLearning platforms CUForum, WebCT and Moodle for years and there are recommendations to have one single eLearning platform only.
- In addition, WebCT would be phased out (obsolete in Jan 2013) and replaced by Blackboard
- Therefore it is now the time to investigate the future eLearning platform for the University.



- The eLearning System Review Panel was formed under AITSC in May 2010.
- The convenor of the Review Panel is Director of IT Services. Members of the Review Panel: 1 to 2 representatives from each Faculty, Library, ITSC and CLEAR.





- Progress so far:
 - Teacher Survey (May 2010)
 - Vendor Presentations (July 2010)
 - Two Half-day workshop on Moodle and Blackboard (Aug 2010)
 - Setup testing platforms and open them to all teachers' testing (Aug – Sep 2010)



 Invite Students testing of Moodle and Blackboard (Oct 2010)



- What to do next:
 - Compare the Total Cost of Ownership
 - Compare the Technical aspects
 - Compare long term benefits to CUHK
