The course template contains teaching materials, URLs and Mashup (e.g. YouTube). After implementing the template to different courses, all teachers and students can share the same set of content simply by accessing their own courses...





Grade Center

Scenario 1

- Students has handed in their homework
- Teachers has used the Track
 Changes function in MS Word to revise the assignment
- Teachers would like to return the revised documents and give comments to students








Scenario 2

- Students have participated in an online test
- Teachers would like to know how students perform in the test (e.g. Mean, Number of attempts, Time used, etc.)



In the <u>Screen Reader mode</u>, the table is static and grades may be entered on the Grade Details page accessed by selecting the table cell for the grade. In the interactive mode of the Grade Center, grades can be typed directly in the cells. Use the arrow keys or the tab key to navigate through the Grade Center and the Enter key to submit a grade. <u>More Help</u>



Report Types

Attempt Statistics	Average score (whole test and each question), Questions, Correct Answer, Percentage Answered of each option
Download results	Download test results in Excel format
View All Attempts	Grade gained by each student, Attempt Number of each students, Date completed, Time used for the test
Column Statistics	Grade Distribution, Median, S.D.





Scenario 3




