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Background

•The Interactive Lounge is a three-year student-centred project funded by Teaching Development and Language Enhancement Grant

- (TDLEG), which was launched by ELTU in 2016 at The Chinese University of Hong Kong.
- The project aims to provide additional support and informal English learning experiences to undergraduates and postgraduates outside of the core curriculum.
- This is achieved by (1) providing a series of interactive workshops of different topics; and (2) offering peer-tutoring services, both online and face-to-face.
