

"The Cantonese Root-searching Journey"




The cross-boundary exchange activity was held from November 2 to 4 in 2018. Students visited Guangzhou and Zhongshan to learn about Cantonese and culture through attending lectures, experiencing fieldwork and visiting scenic spots. During the trip, students had the opportunity to:

master the basic knowledge of Chinese language,
 apply the knowledge and skills to their content subjects
 and also to the real-world situations

- In the semester of 2017/18, the CAC team provided:
