
POINTS TO NOTE

- You can request a **sandbox** (i.e. testing Blackboard course) for testing from us (<u>elearning@cuhk.edu.hk</u>) before deploying the test.
- If your students need to access Blackboard Test at China, you can consider using **Blackboard** (China) system. Contact us at elearning@cuhk.edu.hk for more information.
- Create a trial test for students to get familiar with the test environment beforehand.

REMINDER TO STUDENTS

- Students should take the test with a **stable network**.
- Some test features (e.g. display of images, answer auto-save) are **NOT** available in **Blackboard App**. While students might be able to use Blackboard App to take some tests, we strongly discourage it.
- Do not refresh the page / close window / go back to the previous page while taking the test.



Tests, Surveys, and Pools

Tests

Tests are sets of questions that are graded to measure student performance. Once a test is created here, it must be deployed within a content folder before students can take the test. Test results are reviewed in the Grade Center. Note that some question types are not automatically graded.


Surveys

Surveys are not graded, and student responses are anonymous. They are useful for gathering data from students that is not used to evaluate student performance. Surveys must be deployed in a content folder for students to respond to the survey.


Pools

Pools are sets of questions that can be added to any Test or Survey. Pools are useful for storing questions and reusing them in more than one Test or Survey.

2. Click "Build Test". On the Test Information page, type a name. Click "Submit".



3. On the Test Canvas, click "Question Settings" to check and modify the settings. Rollover "Create Question", select the question type (e.g. Multiple Choice, True/False, Essay...).



If you would like to randomly draw questions from Pool (e.g. draw 30 questions out of 50) so that different students answer different sets of questions, please refer to "Build a Pool" and "Create Question Sets" below.





4. On the Create/Edit page, fill in the information. Select "Submit".



If a test consists of both automatically graded questions (e.g. MC) and manually graded questions (e.g. Essay), the grade would be shown as "Needs Grading" after the submission, as the manually graded questions do not have grades.

5. Questions are created.




Check the questions before deploying the test. Questions cannot be deleted when there are attempts in progress.


Blackboard Help:

1. Access a Content Area (e.g. Course Contents). Select "Assessments" > "Test".




2. Select the test under "Add an Existing Test". Click "Submit". Then select "Test Options" on the next page.



Remember to make the test available to students.

If you have enabled "Force Completion", students are allowed to enter the test once only and it must be completed in one sitting. If a student encounters a technical issue, or closes their browser, they cannot re-enter the test, and you might have to ignore those attempts manually (Click here to learn about "Ignore Attempt").


The **Timer** counts the duration of the test when the student start the test. Students who start late would have the same amount of time to take the test and might still submit it after the "Display Until Date and Time" and the "Due Date".



Due Date: Students can still submit their attempts after **Due Date**. The attempt would be marked as "Late".

You have the option to select "Do not allow students to start the Test if the due date has passed". This option will prevent students from beginning the test after the due date has passed.

Uncheck "Include this Test in Grade Center score calculations" if you don't want the grade to be included in Total Column in Grade Center. By default the Total Column shows total grade to students.




By default, grades for automatically graded tests are shown to students after their submissions.

If you do not want to show grades and/or feedback, uncheck all items under Test Options > "Show test results and feedback to students" and hide Grade Columns (including the "Total" column).
